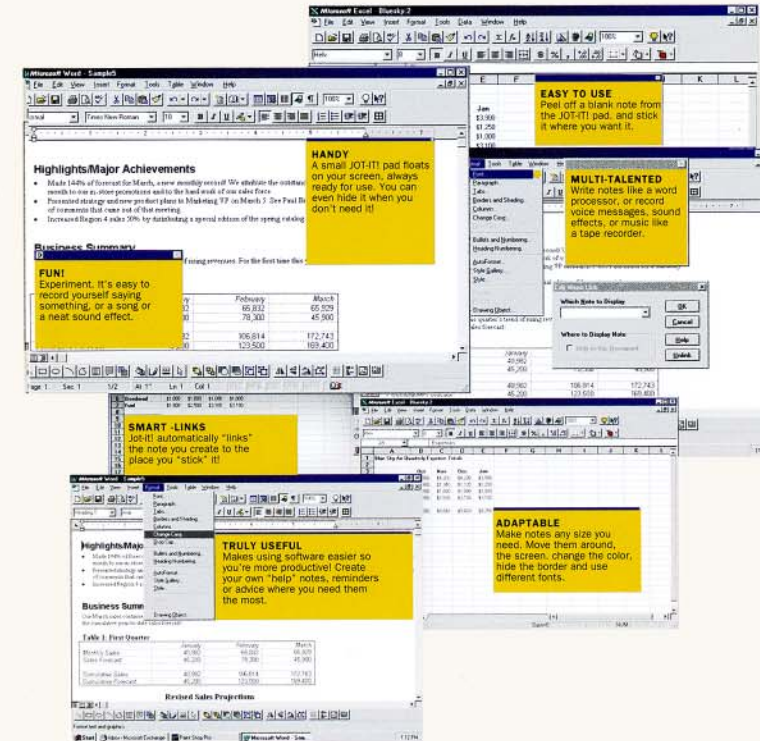

This proprietary technology allows JOT-IT! notes to be intuitively linked to actions or areas in any Windows or Windows 95 application. This makes it tremendously useful for reminders, hints, instructions, or advice on how to do something or on formatting standards, along with simple lists and a tool for jotting down ideas, thoughts, comments, quotes, and the occasional epiphany.



## LINKS!

Jot-it! automatically "links" the note you create to where you "stick" it: in a window, application, document, dialog box, menu, tool bar icon, title bar, even a "hot spot" like a specific area on a screen.

## HANDY!

The notepad floats on your screen, always ready. You can move the notepad around, into an application window or onto a desktop, or even hide it. But it's still there, ready to work for you.

## SMART!

Jot-it! interacts with your applications. It works silently in the background, "watching" the screen and what you're doing. Whenever you do something that you've set up to trigger the appearance of a note, presto, there it is!

## EASY TO USE!

Peel off a blank note. Stick it where you want it. Type in your note, or record a voice message, music, or sound effects. That's it!

## ADAPTABLE!

Make notes any size you need. Move them around the screen, change the color, hide the border and use different fonts.
